

2010 Tuscarawas County Junior Fair King and Queen Contest

Purpose:

To be a spokesperson for the Tuscarawas County Junior Fair Program.

To represent the Tuscarawas County Fair at Junior Fair functions and County wide functions.

The Queen to represent Tuscarawas County at the Ohio State Fair Independent Queen Contest.

Eligibility:

Any older youth enrolled in a 4-H club or FFA Chapter and eligible to exhibit at the Tuscarawas County Junior Fair. Entrants must be between the ages of 16 to 19 (as of January 1).

Must complete an application form and return to the Extension Office by August 20, 2010.

Selection:

Individuals will be interviewed for the selection of king and queen by an adult panel of judges. Crowning of the 2010 Jr. Fair King and Queen will take place the evening before the start of the fair (Sunday, September 19th) in the Main Show Arena. The time is to be determined and will be shared at the time of entrant's interview.

Selection Guidelines:

- a. Junior Fair or Community Involvement
- b. Public Speaking or Public Relations Abilities
- c. Personable Qualities

Court Selection:

Contestants will gather at the Junior Fair Board office on Sunday evening. Time to be determined. Please dress-up for the Occasion. The 2010 King and Queen will each receive a \$250 scholarship, a gift basket, and fair passes that will include admission to other Tuscarawas County Fair Board sponsored events.
