



CHANGES TO THE TUSCARAWAS COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY ON SITE CAMPING

The Tuscarawas County Agriculture Society has discussed and voted on the following changes for camping on the grounds. All changes and new rules apply to all current and new camping applicants.

- Because of lack of space and safety for our 4Hers, camping spots will only be issued to actively participating 4H, FFA and Open Class exhibitors. Current Board members and the electrician will also have access to camping.
- Once you graduate out of 4H or FFA, you will be required to relinquish your camping spot. We will be working with the Extension office to keep track of enrollment and eligibility.
- Camping fees are \$200.00 which includes water and electric.
- All fees **MUST BE PAID** by September 1st or your spot will be released and given to the next person on the waiting list. Payments the week of fair will **NOT** be accepted!
- All permits must be displayed. We will be checking. They have to be visible to the Health Department and the Fire Marshall.
- A new waiting list has been created. Please submit, in writing, to the Tuscarawas County Agricultural Society your request to camp on grounds.
- Due to space limitations and the growing size of campers, camping size restrictions may be limited in the future.
- If you plan to return and you have a larger camper than before, please notify the Tuscarawas County Agricultural Society immediately.
- If you do not plan to return with a camper, please be considerate and notify the Tuscarawas County Agricultural Society secretary as soon as possible.
- All rules and camping information will be published in the Tuscarawas County Agricultural Society fair book.
