GENERAL RULES:

1. Any article left after release time is the full responsibility of exhibitor. Late entries can be displayed but will not be judged.
2. Premiums will be paid only on articles listed in the premium list. Others will not be considered by the judge, who shall refuse to award a prize on any article not deemed worth, whether or not there is competition.
3. In case of only one entry in a class, it will be paid a premium only if deemed worth by the judge.
4. ONLY ONE ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED PER PERSON, PER ITEM IN A CLASS.
5. All articles must be CLEAN and in NEW condition. No worn or soiled articles will be considered by the judge or displayed.
6. Premium cards have no value in the payment of premiums as they are paid only as listed in the judge's report, which are final.
7. ABSOLUTELY NO PURCHASED ARTICLES (except Class 2 Old Quilts)
8. No article can compete that has been exhibited TWICE before at the Tuscarawas County Fair.
9. Claim ticket from entry tags must be presented to claim articles in any dept.
10. Every precaution will be taken for the care of exhibits. TCAS will not be responsible for any changes to or loss of property.
11. NO SUBSTITUTIONS! The item you enter on the form is the only project that will be accepted.
12. Items CAN NOT be dropped off at the Fair board office. Any item(s) left at the office will NOT be entered or displayed.
13. Items must fit into the category. "Other" categories will not be created. Any suggestions for future categories are greatly appreciated.
14. Ribbons will be given to 1st, 2nd and 3rd places.

3. Build a float on top of the shoebox, which is no larger than 14 inches long and 9 inches wide.
4. The float must be made by the exhibitor. Can be made from any material you like. We suggest paper mache, cloth and foil. Secure materials firmly so parts do not blow or fall off.
5. Judging criteria will be: Originality, neatness, craftsmanship, use of material and overall appearance.
6. Claim ticket from entry tag must be presented to pick up exhibit at end of fair.
